## HISTORY PRIMITIVE TECHNOLOGY AND TOOLS

Problem-solving and crafting using simple hand tools. The tools and techniques are often adaptations of those used in Stone Age and Iron Age settlements.



## SCIENCE THE NATURAL WORLD

A key part of bushcraft is understanding the natural

environment and working in harmony with nature. Pupils will learn to identify and categorise different plants, determining their uses based on their physical characteristics. During fire lighting, pupils learn about the fire triangle and friction.


